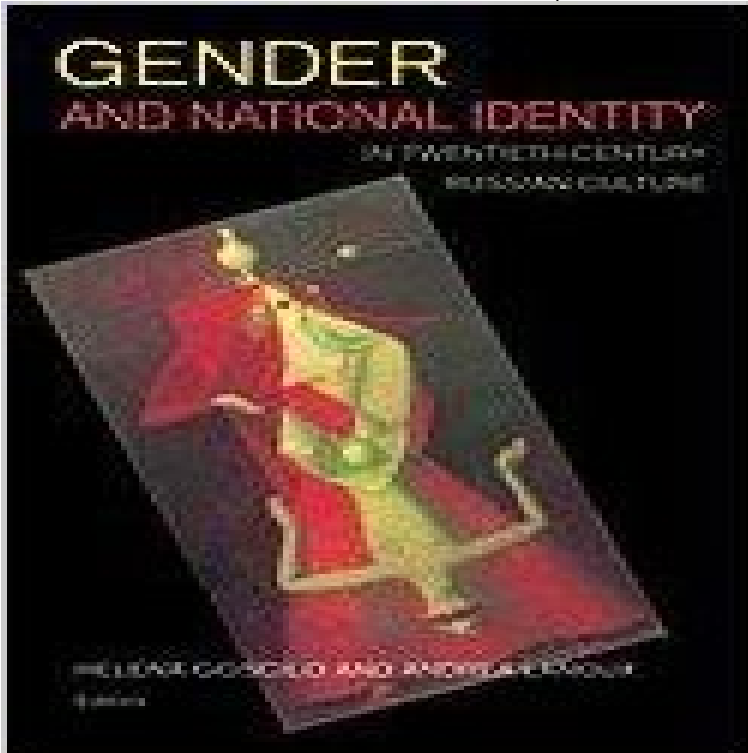


Gender and National Identity in Twentieth-Century Russian Culture
