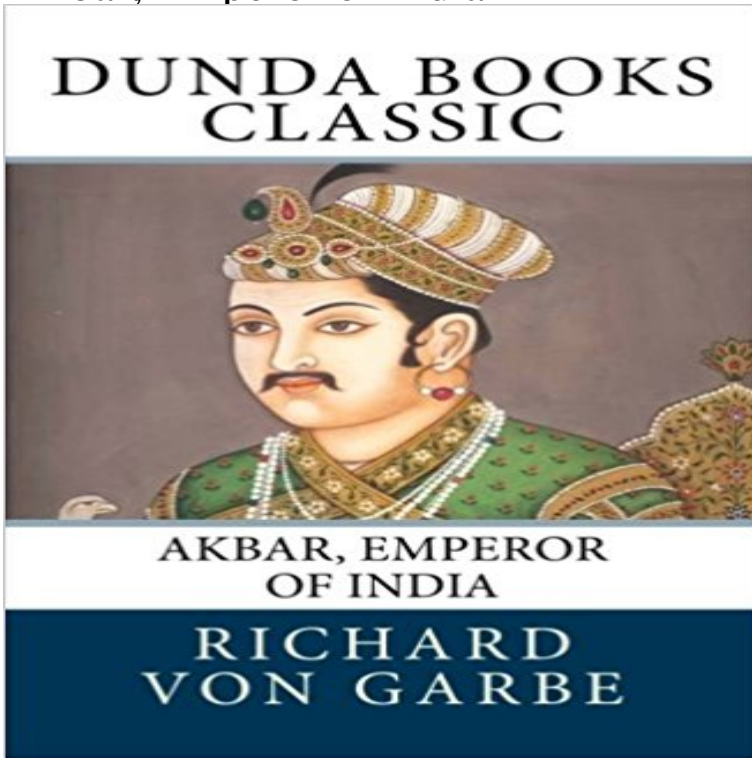


Akbar, Emperor of India
