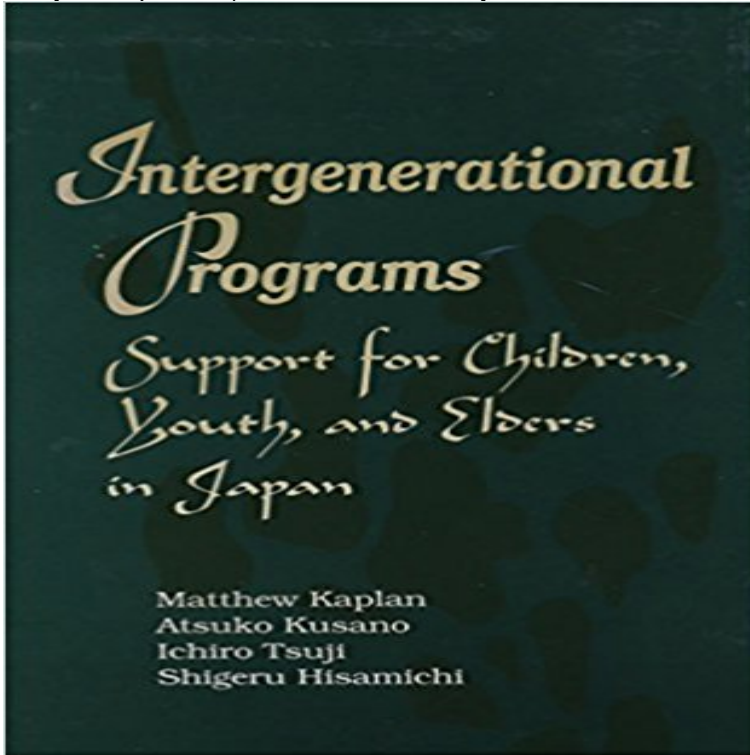


# Intergenerational Programs: Support for Children, Youth, and Elders in Japan (Sunny Series in Japan in Transition)
