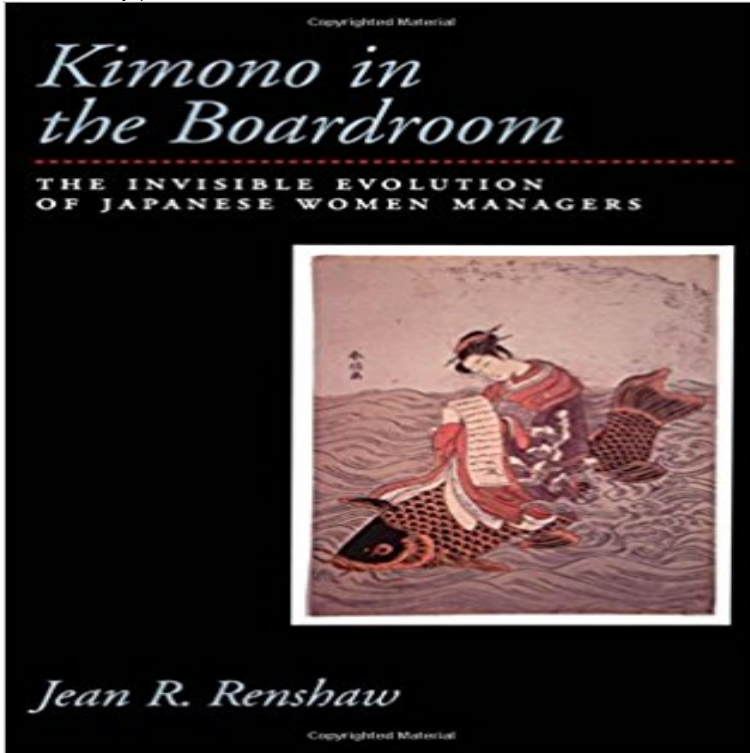


Kimono in the Boardroom: The Invisible Evolution of Japanese Women Managers
